2025 SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION GUIDE

Welcome to the East Haddam Parks & Recreation 2025 Summer Camp Program!

Please read and save this letter as it contains important information.

IMPORTANT NOTE

The last 2 pages of this informational packet is a permission slip form. Please read and sign this form and submit it at least two weeks prior to the start of camp. This completed form must be received before your child can attend camp.

ABOUT OUR PROGRAMS:

Day camp is available to all students entering grades 1-8. (Ages 5-14) Grades are as of Fall 2025.

SPECIFICS - DATE & TIMES:

Camp will be held from Monday, July 7, 2025, through Friday, August 15, 2025. Camp supervision is from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM

AFTER CARE:

After care is also available (for an additional cost) Monday through Friday from 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM.

\$60/week for weeks 1, 3, & 5.

\$48/week for weeks 2 & 4. No after care on Cave Hill days (Thurs. July 17 and Thurs. July 31).

\$36/week for week 6. No after care on Cave Hill day (Wed. August 13) and last day of camp (Fri. August 15).

*Please be sure to arrive promptly by **5:00 PM** for after care pick up. It is important to note that this program operates with a strict threestrike policy, which is detailed in the table below*

First Infraction	Warning issued
Second Infraction	\$10 fine per every 10 minutes you are late
Third Infraction	Child withdrawn from after care program with no refund

PICK UP AND DROP OFF INFORMATION:

Check-in is between 8:00 AM and 8:30 AM and will be held in the back parking lot of the Nathan Hale-Ray Middle School near the softball field.

A parent or authorized adult must sign their camper out with a staff member, including after field trips. Only adults who've been authorized on your child's registration form or by written permission may pick your child up. If the staff does not recognize the individual, photo identification will be required.

We also ask that all campers please keep electronics/phones at home. Camp is an opportunity for them to unplug and engage with one another and our counselors. Phone use for medical reasons such as glucose monitoring is permitted.

Please sign your child out between 2:45 and 3:00 PM, OR between 4:45 and 5:00 PM if registered for after care. Children are allowed to arrive late and leave early if necessary - please notify a staff member if you plan to do so.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

Please note that registration is on a first come, first served basis, and that registration is only considered complete once it has been submitted and payment has been accepted.

Registration forms can be accessed and submitted on our website (www.easthaddamrec.com

Payments can be made in person (at the Parks & Rec office), online, (www.easthaddamrec.com), or over the phone (860) 873-5058. Please note that payment is expected at the time of registration and that the registration deadline is two weeks prior to the start of an individual week.

(Example: If you are registering your child for Week 1, the registration deadline will be Monday, June 23 since camp begins on Monday, July 7).

Financial assistance is available to those who qualify thanks to our Lukas Breton Scholarship Fund. Scholarship details and application can be found on our website: easthaddamrec.com.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION CONTINUED:

The price of camp does not include the cost of field trips, and is as follows:

Weekly	Weeks 1, 3, & 5: \$180 Weeks 2, 4, & 6: \$200 All 6 Weeks: \$1,065
After Care (weekly)	Weeks 1, 3, & 5: \$60 Weeks 2 & 4: \$48 Week 6: \$36

Refunds, less a 6% processing fee (per child, per week), will be given only if the child has been withdrawn by a <u>written request</u> no later than 1 week before the session they are registered for begins. A change in session may be made at no charge if space is available.

FIELD TRIP SPECIFICATIONS:

Our campers will have the opportunity to attend numerous field trips throughout our six weeks of camp.

All field trip details may be found in their own individual itineraries. Links to these itineraries can be found on the East Haddam Parks & Rec website (on the camp field trip registration page) and printed copies will be available at camp.

Most field trips will return to camp before 3:00 PM. However, the following trip will return after 4:00 PM.

Please note: On Town Beach days and field trips that your child will be wearing a swimsuit, please be sure that they arrive at camp already wearing their swimsuit under their clothes, and bring a towel, sunscreen, and change of clothing.

SUNSCREEN & MEDICATION REGULATIONS:

- Please be aware that all physical health forms must be up to date and received 2 weeks prior to attending camp. Any physical dated within two years of camp attendance dates is valid for our purposes.
- According to the Connecticut State Statutes, topical over-the-counter medications (such as sunscreen and insect repellant) do not need a physician's order.
- Sunscreen may not be sufficient protection for every child. Please provide the camp with written instructions if you wish for your child to wear a hat or shirt all day, or if you wish them to keep any articles of clothing on over their swimsuit while in the water. Additionally, we appreciate your cooperation in applying your child's first application of sunscreen or topical medication before they arrive to camp each day. The staff will remind all campers to re-apply sunscreen at 10:00 AM and 12:30 PM and will offer assistance to those who may need it.
- According to the Connecticut State Statutes, your child's physician must complete
 a medication authorization for each prescription and oral over-the counter
 medication that you wish our staff to administer. Otherwise, you may bring these
 medications to our site and administer them yourself at the time(s) your child will
 need it.
- If you wish for our staff to administer your child's medication, please bring the completed authorization form(s), along with the medication(s), to the program on the first day it is needed.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- All our Summer Camp staff are CPR and First Aid certified.
- Please be sure that your child brings bottled water, a snack, and lunch every day.
- While certain attire has been outlined for each field trip, please dress your child appropriately for the weather.
- In the event of severe weather, outdoor field trips may be rescheduled.
- Our staff or local news outlets may photograph children in the program. If you do not wish your child's name or photograph to appear in a newspaper, on the town website, in Parks & Rec emails or program flyers, on bulletin boards, or in any media not otherwise specified, please indicate this clearly in the comments section of the registration form.
- Children who are disruptive, or cannot adapt to the program, may be withdrawn. East Haddam Parks & Recreation does not tolerate bullying or harassment, in any capacity, in any of our programs.

CONTACT INFORMATION:
